Make a Difference in S. Sudan!

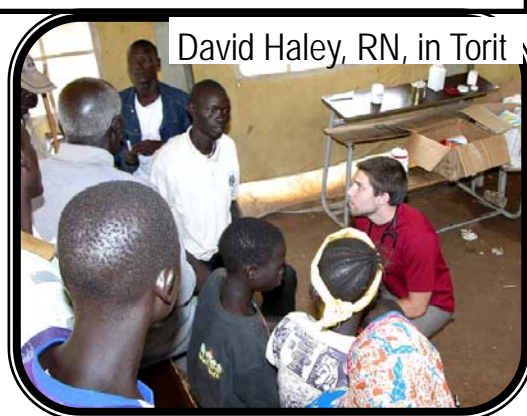
1. **Southern** Sudanese experienced 21 years of war and are rebuilding their lives. In all of South Sudan, there are about 50 miles of paved roads and a generation has been out of school. Drought has hit subsistence farmers in Eastern Equatoria province, although rains have now come.
2. This is our fifth ministry trip, working with the same S. Sudanese partners. Our objectives are to meet spiritual and health needs of S. Sudanese. We offer seminars, medical services (as personnel are available), and evangelistic outreach. Through partnership with U.S. churches, we're engaged in church planting in three villages and in the sub-provincial capital of Torit. The population is about 50% Christian.
3. Our teams are relational and multicultural. We go to serve, rather than to observe.
4. The fee is \$2,100, plus round-trip airfare to Entebbe, Uganda. Our agent provides discounted fares on quality airlines, with excellent service. Immunizations, visas, and outfitting are extra.
5. Ask the Lord if this is your time, and this is your opportunity. The cutoff date is March 5, 2011 and the team minimum is four members. Many return several times.
