## Spread the Word, Year One of S. Sudan

1. The needs of S. Sudanese are great--27% of adults read and 55% have good water to drink (see <http://ssnbs.org>).
2. If you can do it, chances are, it's needed, and we can put you to work.
3. This is our sixth ministry trip, working with the same S. Sudanese partner. Our objectives are to meet spiritual and health needs of S. Sudanese. We offer seminars, medical services (as personnel are available), evangelistic outreach, and a building opportunities. Through partnership with U.S. churches, we're engaged in church planting, pastoral training and micro-economic development in the Torit area. The population is about 50% Christian.
4. Our teams are relational and multicultural. We go to serve, rather than to observe.
5. The fee is \$2,200, plus round-trip airfare to Entebbe, Uganda. Our agent provides discounted fares on quality airlines, with excellent service. Immunizations, visas, and outfitting are extra.
6. You can become a liaison for your church to get involved. Team members' lives have been changed. Go into all the world, including S. Sudan.

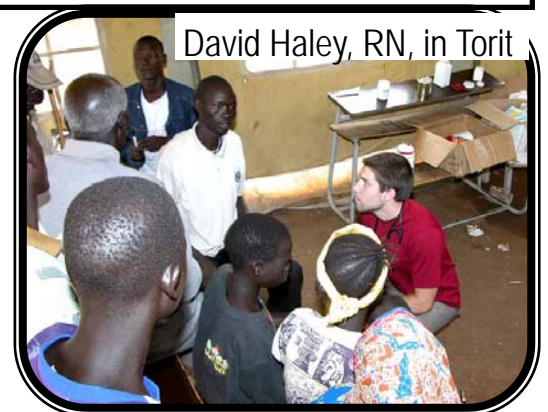
